Do you have an idea for reaching Australia with the Gospel? See the possibilities of something bigger than your church or organisation's mission in making an impact for Jesus? Have a plan but need a financial partner?

The United Evangelistic Council is an evangelical not for profit organisation that exists to encourage and sponsor the promotion of the Christian gospel in Sydney and NSW. The Council holds the left-over funds from the 1959 Billy Graham Crusades, and acts as a catalyst to increase and enhance the joint evangelistic efforts of evangelical churches and organisations.

Examples of UEC-sponsored projects and events over the last 50 years include:

- **Leighton Ford mission at the Sydney Entertainment Centre in 1986**
- **Bicentennial Bible distribution to homes throughout Australia in 1988**
- **Conferences on evangelism and church planting in the 1990s and 2000s**
- **Multi-church missions in St George and Wollongong (2011, 2014)**

The UEC welcomes applications from individuals, churches and organisations for the financial support of evangelistic projects and events. Proposed projects may take a number of forms including large-scale evangelistic events, conferences, training courses, or publishing projects. All projects, however, must be evangelical in conviction, evangelistic in focus, interdenominational in scope, and demonstrably limited by lack of available funds.

Information for Applicants

All applications will be assessed according to the following four criteria:

- i. Evangelical Conviction: the proposal affirms the doctrinal commitments in the UEC Statement of Faith.**
- ii. Evangelistic Focus: the proposal seeks to present the gospel of Christ from the Scriptures, and prayerfully aims at the conversion of unbelievers to faith in the Lord Jesus.**
- iii. Interdenominational Scope: the proposal involves Christian churches/groups from at least two different denominations/movements.**
- iv. Lack of Funds: the proposal is demonstrably limited by a lack of available funds, and is unable to secure funding from other sources.**

- 1. The divine inspiration and infallibility of Holy Scripture as originally given and its supreme authority in all matters of faith and conduct.**
 - 2. The unity of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit in the Godhead.**
 - 3. The universal sinfulness and guilt of humanity since the fall, rendering men and women subject to God's wrath and condemnation.**
 - 4. The conception of Jesus Christ by the Holy Spirit and his birth by the Virgin Mary.**
 - 5. Redemption from the guilt, penalty of the power of sin only through the sacrificial death, as our representative and substitute, of Jesus Christ, the incarnate Son of God.**
 - 6. The bodily resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.**
 - 7. The necessity of the work of the Holy Spirit to make the death of Christ effective in the individual sinner, granting him or her repentance towards God, and faith in Jesus Christ.**
 - 8. The indwelling and work of the Holy Spirit in the believer.**
 - 9. The expectation of the personal return of the Lord Jesus Christ.**
